PROTECTIVE ORDER


It is hereby ORDERED that the plaintiffs may designate documents produced pursuant to this Court's March 15, 2007 order as "Confidential Material" subject to this Protective Order. Such designation shall be made by marking "Confidential Material" on the front page of all such documents. Such Confidential Material shall be used only for the purposes of this litigation and shall not be disclosed to anyone except the parties, counsel to the parties in this litigation, their employees and support staff, the parties' experts, if any, concerning Defendant's fee application, and court personnel and court reporters.

It is further ORDERED that the legend "Confidential Material – Subject to Protective Order" must appear on the front page of all documents filed with the Court that contain information obtained from Confidential Material or that have any Confidential Material included or used in any exhibit. All Confidential Material shall be filed under seal, subject to the Court's rules and procedures. Upon

final conclusion of this litigation (including the exhaustion of all appeals), Confidential Material produced in this litigation shall, upon request of the producing party, be either destroyed or returned to that party.

Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to restrict the right of any Party to give its own Confidential Materials to others or to use its own Confidential Material in any manner that it sees fit. Additionally, nothing in this order shall prevent the Court from disclosing Confidential Material, if necessary, as part of any subsequent order respecting attorneys' fees. This Protective Order is effective immediately and shall survive the conclusion of this litigation. This Court shall retain jurisdiction for the purpose of enforcing the terms of this Protective Order.
