**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. For the period January 1, 2003, to December 31, 2006, each plaintiff shall turn over to defendant's counsel, within twenty (20) days of the date hereof, copies of (a) its contracts with its twelve (12) largest customers for wholesale downloads, and (b) documents sufficient to indicate the volume of downloads sold at the respective prices.

2. The documents themselves, the identities of the parties, and all other details shall be confidential except (a) the prices and (b) the volume. Subsequent to the production of the documents to defendant's counsel, defendant's counsel may serve notices to admit, relating solely to the totals of prices and to totals of volume, without violating the within order.

3. The confidential materials shall be disclosed to no person outside of defendant's counsel's law firm, except one or more certified public accountants and/or expert witnesses who shall have executed agreements to be bound by the within order under penalty of contempt of court, except under subpoena or court order. In the event defendant's counsel shall receive a subpoena or court order for any documents designated as confidential herein, they shall

promptly notify the Court and plaintiff's counsel of same, and shall send copies of same, and shall send a copy of the within order to the party or forum issuing said subpoena or order, but shall have no further obligation with respect thereto.

4. "End date" is defined as the earlier of (a) the date the parties enter into a non-confidential stipulation of uncontested facts as to price and volume or (b) the date on which a judgment is entered disposing of all of the rights and duties of all of the parties hereto, and all rights to file appeals, petitions for certiorari, petitions for rehearing, and other rights of review have been exhausted. Within 60 days after the End date, defendant's counsel shall return all documents provided hereunder, destroy any copies in their possession, and delete any digital copies they have made.

5. The parties may stipulate to modify the within order without making further application to the Court, and any such stipulation shall have the full force and effect of the within order.
