

TRIAL PROCEDURES

Counsel for plaintiffs is to submit a copy of all materials for trial to Judge Tucker L. Melançon's Chambers, 800 Lafayette Street, Suite 4700, Lafayette, Louisiana, 70501, either by hand or direct mail.

1. **TRIAL OUTLINE:**

- a. The outline from the plaintiffs is to contain each claim made against the defendant, the basis in law relied upon for those claims, if codal or statutory

cite the specific portion of the statute or code article relied upon, any jurisprudential gloss upon the statute or code article relied upon, any jurisprudential gloss upon the statute or codal authority is to be cited with the page cite where the specific language relied upon is located, which supports or interprets plaintiff's claim. The plaintiffs are to cite the standard or burden of proof they must prove as to each claim and is to delineate each type of remedy sought and its basis in law as well as the standard or burden of proof he must establish to obtain that particular remedy, including any right to attorney's fees.

2. EXHIBITS:

a. The plaintiffs are to state briefly for what purpose they are offering each exhibit.

3. WILL CALL WITNESS LIST:

a. The plaintiffs shall list the name, address and a brief description of the expected testimony of each witness the party will call at trial.
